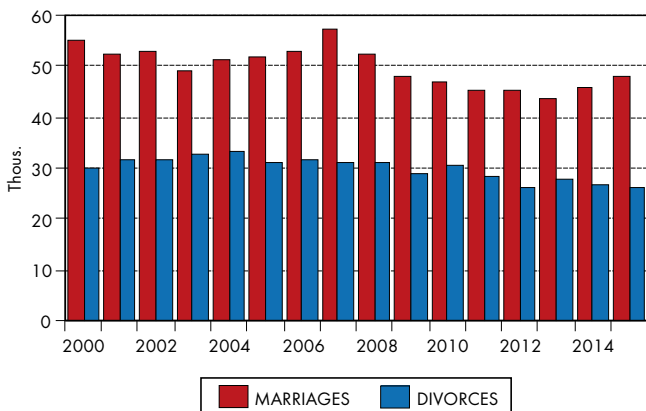

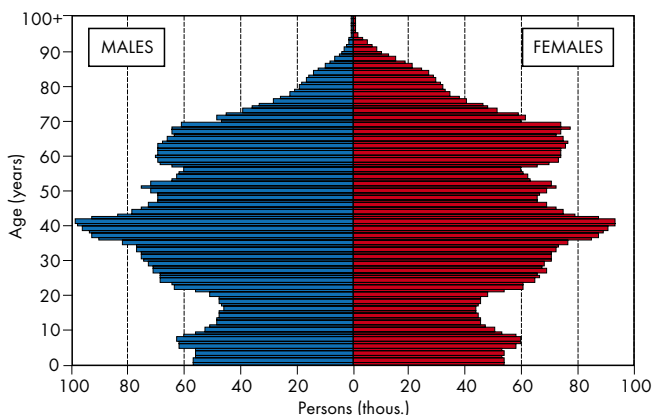

CONFERENCES IN COLLECTIVE ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS IN 2015



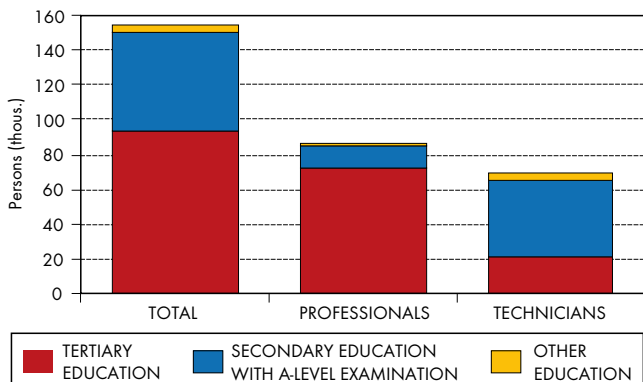

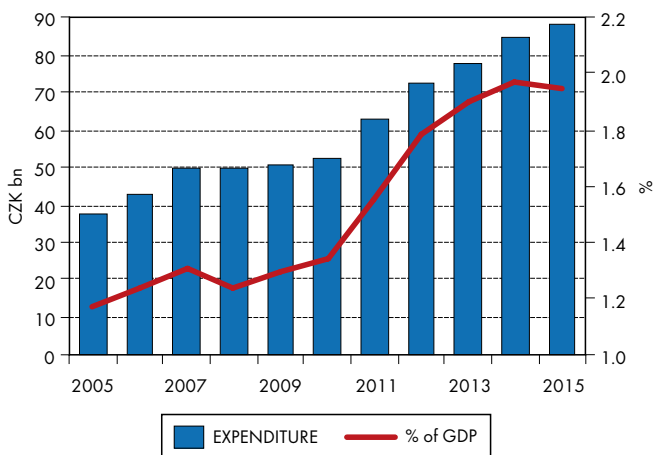

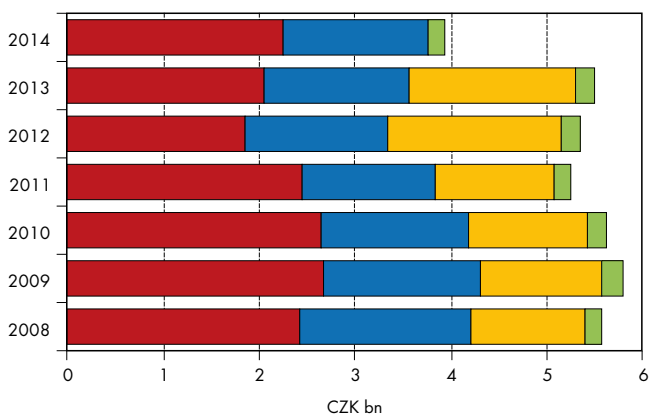

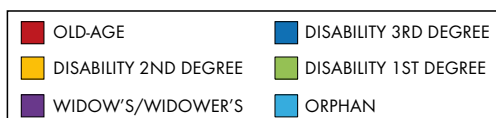
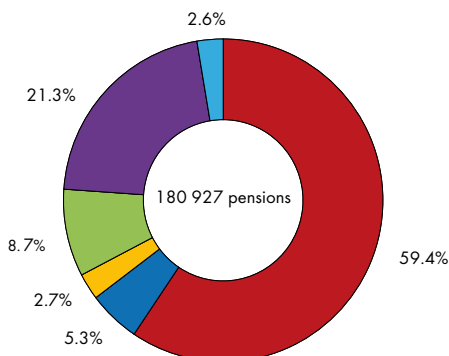
PATIENTS' EXPENDITURE ON REGULATION FEES

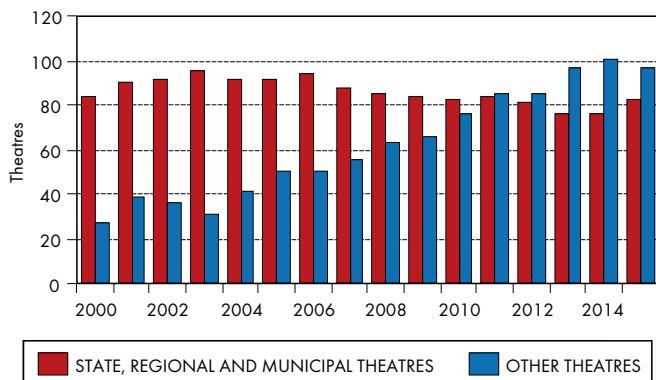

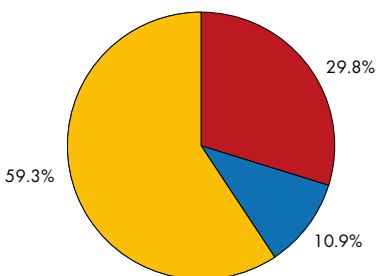
