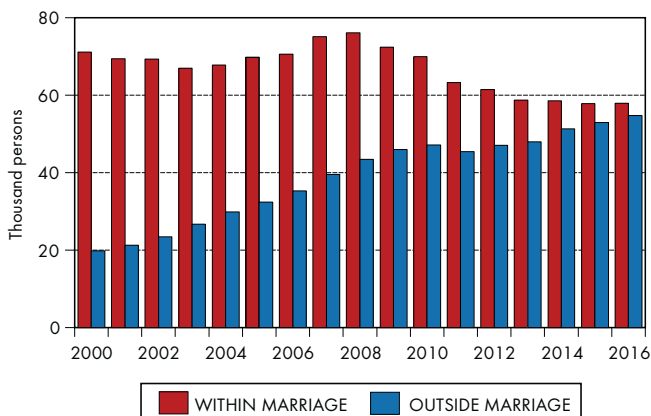

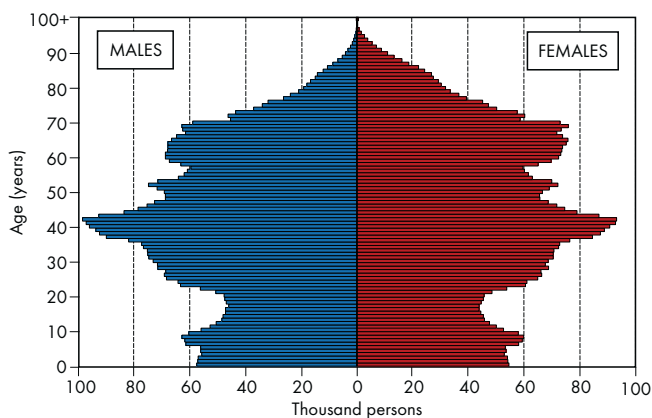

SHARE OF THE SELF-EMPLOYED IN THE TOTAL NUMBER OF THE EMPLOYED

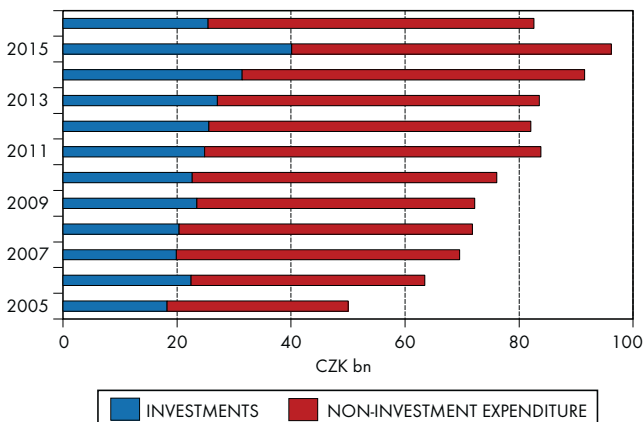

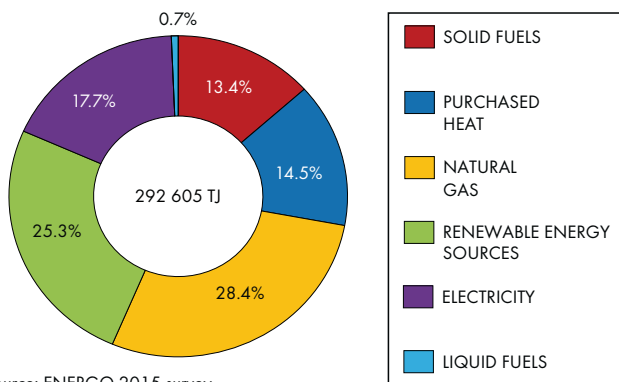

FINAL FUEL AND ENERGY CONSUMPTION IN HOUSEHOLDS BY END-USE IN 2015



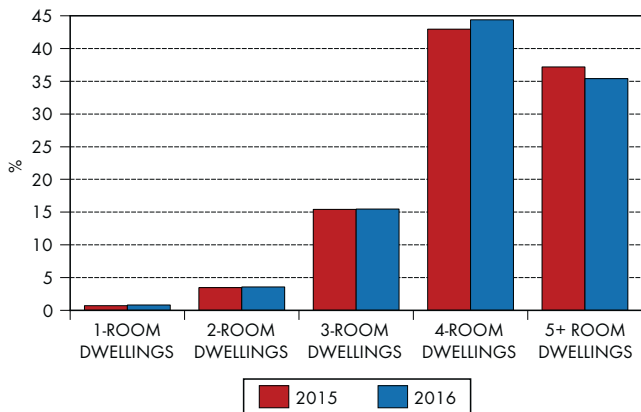

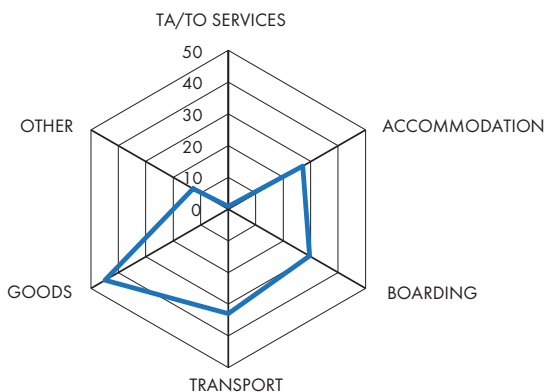

INBOUND TOURISM CONSUMPTION IN 2015 (CZK bn)

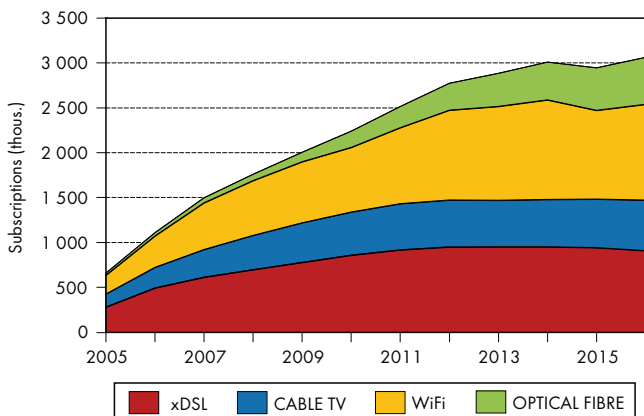

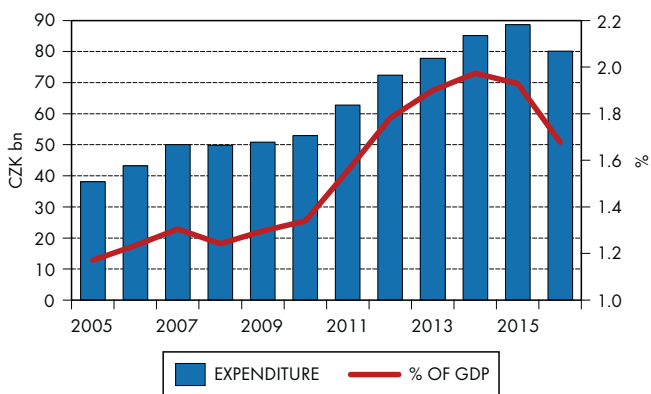

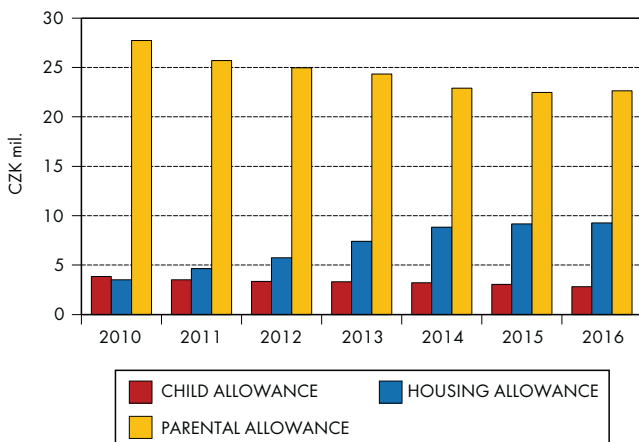
INCAPACITY FOR WORK DUE TO DISEASE OR INJURY

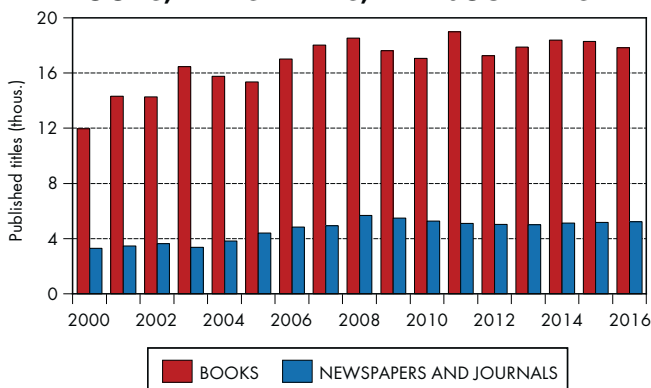

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE OF THE NATIONAL ECONOMY

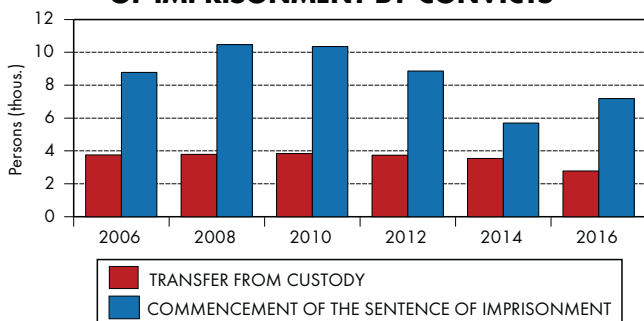
