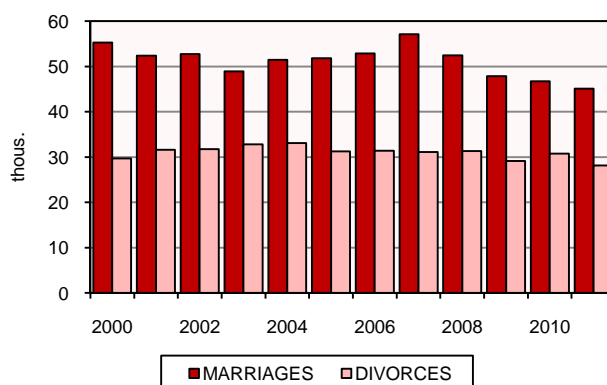

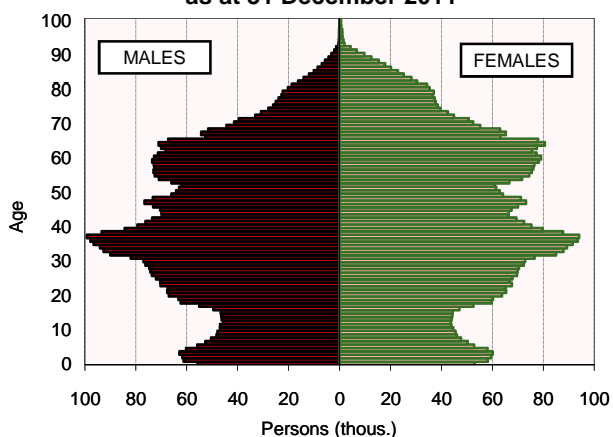

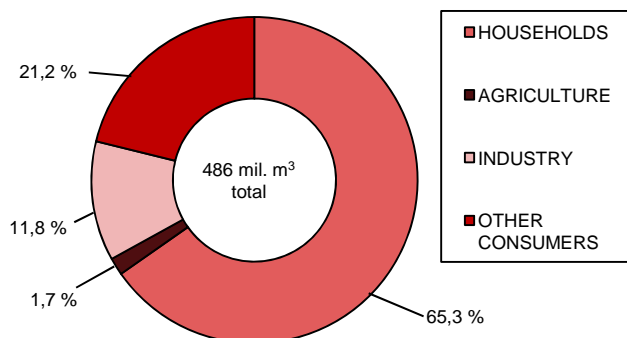
UNEMPLOYED PERSONS PER JOB VACANCY

STRUCTURE OF INVOICED DRINKING WATER 2011



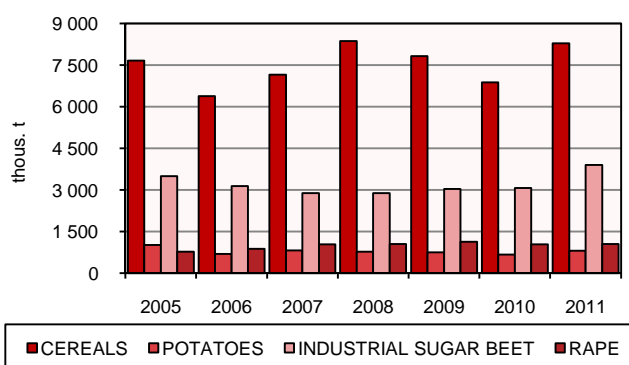

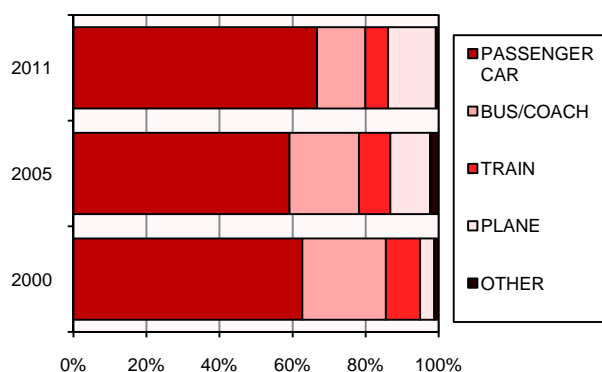

LONG LEISURE TRIPS BY MEANS OF TRANSPORT USED



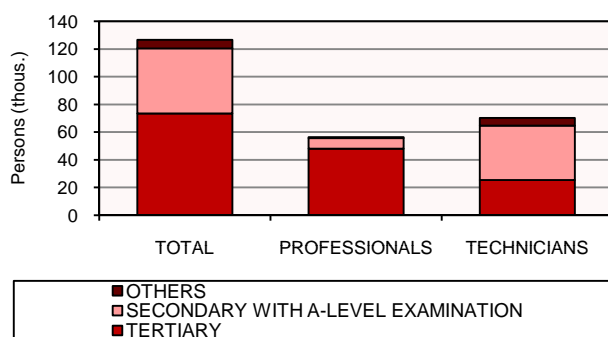

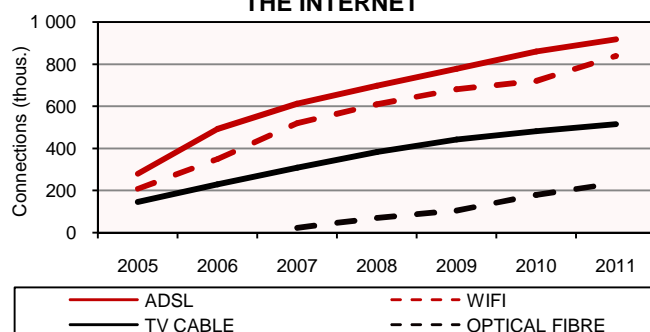

FIXED-LINE BROADBAND CONNECTION TO THE INTERNET

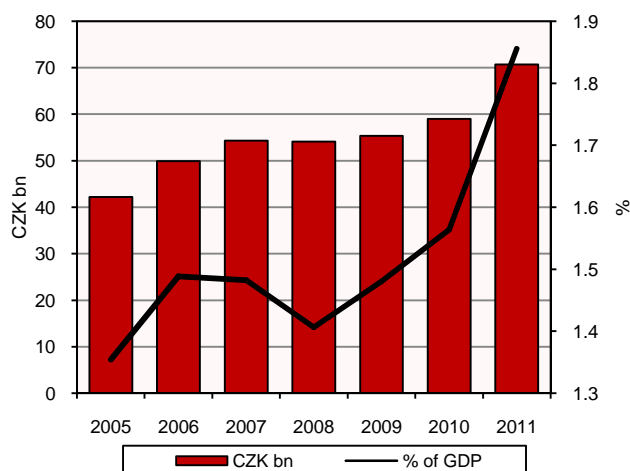

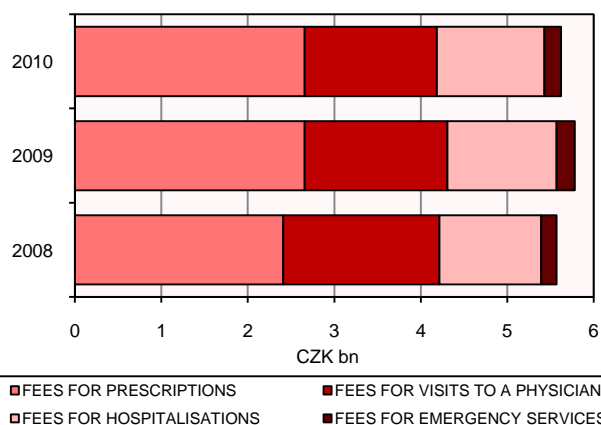

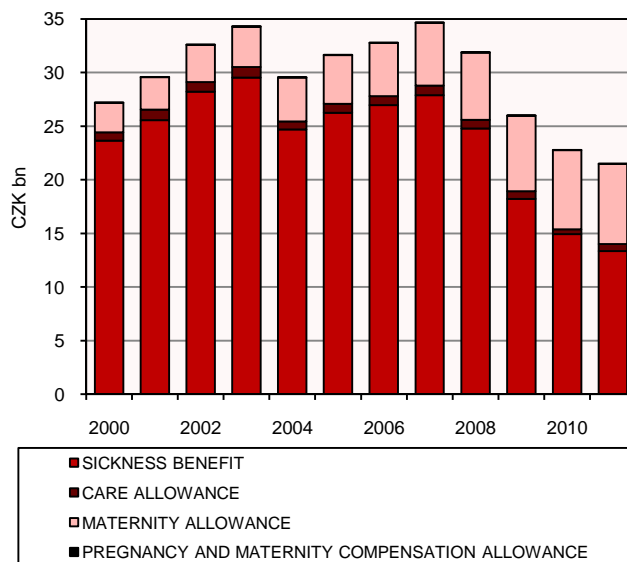
PATIENTS' EXPENDITURE ON REGULATION FEES

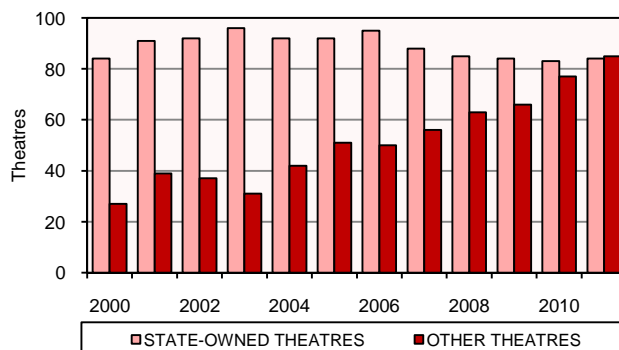

OF THE NATIONAL ECONOMY**

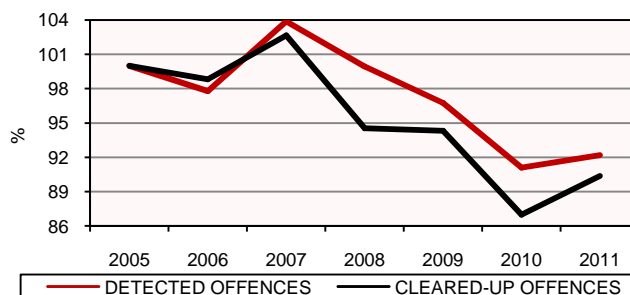
