Why change ?

- Software and user interface :
 - Technical performance at its limits (indexing,..., upload of GL preprints)
 - Features requested by users (export records)
- Content :
 - Improve information on access to the document
 - Add new records
 - Add links to full text

Change and Continuity

- Software change from DSpace to
 - ❑ Exalead - search engine for the database,
 - ❑ In-house developments using php and MySql software for the user interface

- Persistent identifier
 - ❑ Each record in OpenGrey is identified by a unique identifier, the **handle**.
 - ❑ These handles had to be transferred from the old system to the new one.
 - ❑ Redirections were added for bookmarked pages (collections, individual records)

Abstract : This thesis describes in detail the difficulty in choosing an appropriate distribution strategy, which must respect the trends of modern business and as well as the influence of internationalization, globalization and differentiation of the markets. The change in final customers' purchasing behaviour is another important influence. The factors mentioned above require changes in management systems, changes which include all partners who are involved in the process of meeting customers' expectations and predicting changes in those expectations, business activities included. Because of author's job orientation, the main target of this work is to analyze and compare the theoretical aspects recommended in structuralization of distribution systems; to describe in detail the distribution channels currently in use; to classify the factors and theory influencing the choice of a appropriate distribution strategy; to compare the theoretical approach with practical experience and to propose a distribution strategy for a company oriented towards sales of fast-moving consumer goods with an extensive distribution system. Closely tied to the theoretical chapters are two practical applications: the creation of a new distribution system and the application of a differentiated distribution strategy. The practical part of this dissertation and its conclusions highlight the importance of taking into consideration the variety of distribution channels and the contemporary economic situation. The author has not used real values for financial information as the company, Coty, feels some information to be part of its trade secrets. All financial information linked to Czech and Slovak crowns appearing in the text, charts and tables of this work are adjusted by applying a coefficient recommended by the company. The coefficient is a constant. The use of this constant allows us to follow the logic of the calculations without using the real values. ;

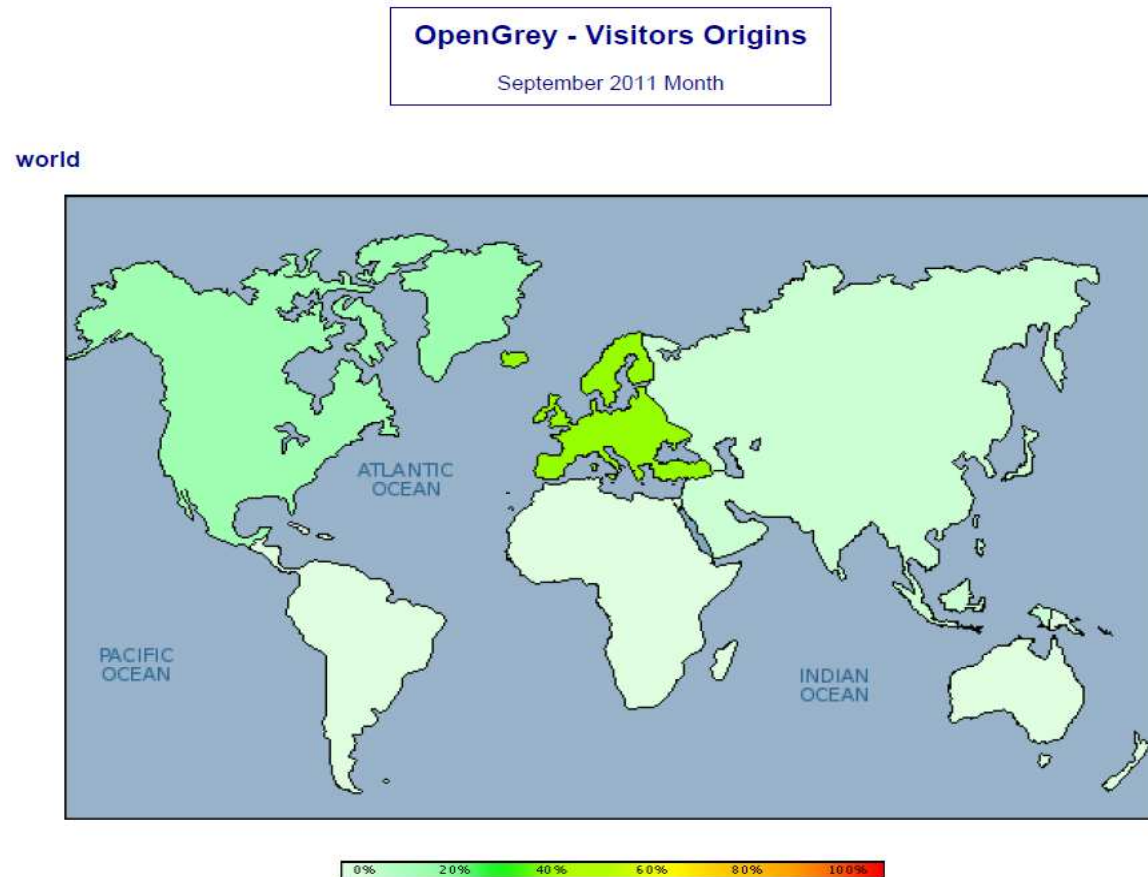
First results on OpenGrey usage



- Statistics tool : Google analytics and an in-house development
- Results similar to summer 2010
 - 30 000 visits in September and
 - 70 000 page views
- New : access with mobile devices can be monitored
- Czech collection (5778 records)
 - Since the opening of OpenGrey Czech records have been accessed 22 000 times

European content for a worldwide audience

- 160 different countries in one month
- United Kingdom and USA in the lead
- Increasing access from
 - Australia
 - China
 - India



Further developments

- Re-indexing by Google and Google Scholar still ongoing
 - OAI-PMH - create sets to facilitate harvesting on a subject basis
 - Improve record display
 - Provide facility to share contents

 - Improve tools and presentations for partners (administration)
